

## 2010-2011 M-H-LT SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST\*

**SPECIAL NOTE:** Due to our wooden gym floor all students must have a pair of non-marking lace up (not slip on, zip-up, or raised heel) gym shoes that remain at school for gym class. They must have the student's name marked in them.

### Kindergarten

Large back pack
